



VISA REGULATIONS FOR VISITORS TO TANZANIA
VISA HOURS ARE BETWEEN 9.30 AM TO 1.00 PM MONDAY TO FRIDAY

1. Submit

- (i) One duly complete visa application form,
- (ii) A valid passport with at least 6 months before expiration date, with 2 blank pages.
Note; Amendment pages are not for visa issuance.
- (iii) One standard passport sized photo (measures 2x2)
- (iv) **COPIES of itineraries; AIR and INLAND are MANDATORY**
- (v) **Volunteer visa - LETTER from HOST is REQUIRED**
- (vi) **Business visa - LETTER from EMPLOYER / and HOST in Tanzania is MANDATORY**
- (vii) Proof of having sufficient funds to maintain the applicant while in Tanzania. This can be done via Bank statement, employer letter or a pay stub.

2. Visa Fee for US citizens is \$100, valid for 1 year, multiple entry visa.

European Nations visa fee is **\$50**, valid for three months, single entry

For all other nations the visa fee may vary from one country to another depending on the reciprocity arrangements. An extra \$20 is charges for Rush Service (24 - 48hrs), Regular service is 3-5 business days. **Personal Checks are NOT ACCEPTED!** (CASH or MONEY ORDER/ CASHIER CHECK payable to TANZANIA MISSION TO THE UN)

3. If applying by mail do enclosed a self-address stamped envelope (meter stamp are not accepted) (Registered, Certified Priority, Express mail or UPS)

4. Nationals of the following countries Do Not Require Visas when their intended stay does not exceed three months: **Botswana, Gambia, Ghana, Hong Kong (special administrative Region of China), Kenya Republic, Lesotho Kingdom, Malawi, Malaysia, Mozambique, Namibia, Rwanda, Swaziland, Uganda, Zambia and Zimbabwe and Common Wealth Member States Except UNITED KINGDOM, SOUTH AFRICA, NIGERIA, NEW ZEALAND, INDIA, CANADA, BANGLADESH AND AUSTRALIA**

5. Nationals of the following countries must have their request for visa referred to the Director Immigration Service in Tanzania: Abkhazia, Afghanistan, Azerbaijan, Bangladesh, Chad, Djibouti, Equatorial Guinea, Ethiopia, Eritrea, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Lebanon, Mali, Mauritania, Morocco, Niger, Palestine, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Somalia, Somali Land, Sri Lanka, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan, Refugees and Stateless Persons. It should be noted that all visitors who fall under this category may not be allowed entry into Tanzania, without being in possession of Referred visa. (Allow 4 weeks processing time)

6. Visas for Research, Journalism, Photographers, Film/Video producers and Book writers will only be granted after the applicants have been cleared by the Ministry of Information, Culture and Sports. Look for the forms on the visa forms area.

7. Visas may be obtained from any Tanzania Diplomatic Mission abroad, or upon arrival at any point of entry in Tanzania, but it is advisable to secure visas before commencing your journey, whenever possible. In the United States, visas can be obtained from the Tanzania Mission in New York or at the Tanzania Embassy in Washington DC.
